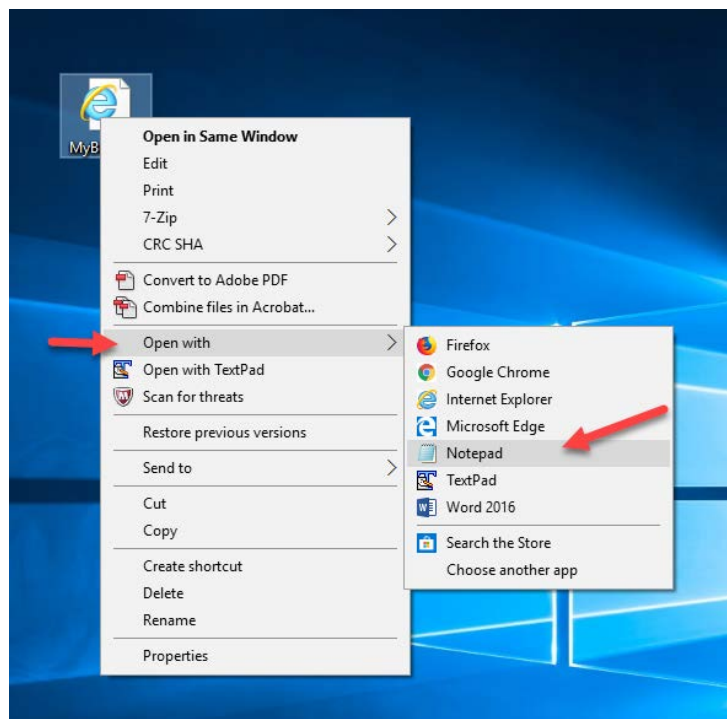


Due to a recent Microsoft upgrade, the Saved Inventory that was exported as an HTML file from Savings Bond Wizard to your desktop may be inoperable. Here are two options:

- Use Mozilla Firefox browser. The Wizard Inventory file will open correctly with this browser, which was not affected by the Microsoft upgrade. You can download this free browser from <https://www.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/new/>
- If you prefer to continue using Internet Explorer browser, you can repair the issue to your Savings Bond Wizard Inventory HTML file using the steps below:
 1. Right-click on the saved inventory HTML file on your desktop.
 2. Select “Open with” and then select “Notepad” or “TextPad.”




3. Scroll down through the file until you see `<form method="post" action="http://www.treasurydirect.gov/BC/SBCPrice">`.

4. Insert the letter "s" in lower case at the end of "http."



6. Click on "File" and then "Save."



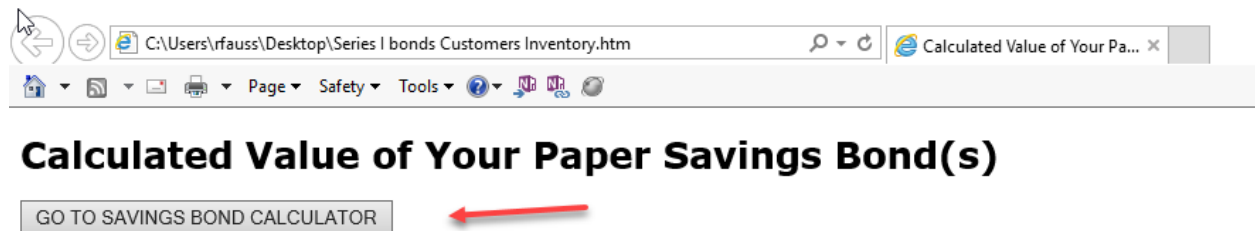

7. Close the file by clicking on the “X” in the upper right hand corner.



8. Double-click the file icon on your desktop to reopen to the newly repaired html page. When the HTML page opens, click on “GO TO SAVINGS BOND CALCULATOR.”



9. The inventory should now load to Savings Bond Calculator.
10. To save your inventory, click the “Save” button in the results area and then when the list appears, click “File” and “Save As” and name your inventory. Make sure that you save your file as an "HTML Only" file and click “Save.” If you would like more detail, see [“Savings Bonds Calculator Inventory Instructions.”](#)
